NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARIES OFFICE by 4pm, Wednesday Sept. 8, 2010, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled or substituted. Make check payable to PARKERSBURG OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB, INC. (POTC). All entry fees must be made payable in US funds.

POSTDATED OR RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom, by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

NO SMOKING in the building.

ALL HANDLERS MUST clean up after their own dogs.
