NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARIES OFFICE by 7pm, Wednesday Sept. 7, 2011, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled or substituted. Make check payable to PARKERSBURG OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB, INC. (POTC). All entry fees must be made payable in US funds.

POSTDATED OR RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom, by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form will not be accepted. **A \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and a \$.50 AKC recording fee or a \$3.00 AKC recording fee for Rally** will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial, rally trial, or tracking test. This fee is collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If the dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the fee is to be collected on the first entry only.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. **NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED** if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the management.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in making out the entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

THE TRIAL GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handler, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES and a judging program will be made as soon as possible after entries close. Should such an acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON after the closing date may have their entry fees refunded less \$4.00 per entry upon written certification by a veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than 10:00 am the day of the Trial.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial and top awards of a breed.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED at the trial or they become the property of the Parkersburg Obedience Training Club Inc. None will be mailed.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

NO SMOKING in the building.

ALL HANDLERS MUST clean up after their own dogs.

HOW TO USE THE POTC ENTRY FORM

Use one entry per dog and check the blocks for each trial in which you wish to enter. Use a separate form if you are entering your dog in a different class on different days or in different trials.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From the north or south, take I-77 to exit 1 in Ohio. At exit 1, take ramp right for OH-7 toward Marietta, bear right onto OH-7/ Newport Pike. Bear right onto OH-26/ N 7th St/ State Route 26, and then immediately bear left onto N 7th St, name changes to Clifton St. Turn left onto Gross St.

Plenty of space for RVs, no hook ups.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
